## ABOUT THIS ROLE

---



This role is a unique blend of creative practice and early years teacher.

Most of your time will be spent on planning, preparation and being in the classroom. Along with some elements of admin and team management.

With a primary focus on children under 3 years old, our classes are often a families first experience of activities for their child. Support often extends from the children to their parents/carers.

Working with the Principal and supported by the wider classes team, the Manager oversees all aspects of the Creative Classes, maintaining the high standard of our classes, relationships with children, parents and as a team

During each of our 3 classes a day the Manager works in a two-person team with either a Musician or Montessori Teacher, leading a class of 8-12 children and their accompanying adult. The Manager leads the art, treasure basket, messy play, STEM activities in our classes and then switches into supporting the children and parents during the music/Montessori activities.

## APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

---

Experience of working with young children, Early Years essential and preferably under 3 years old, and knowledge of child development (essential).

Must have knowledge of art/sensorial activities suitable for 1-3 year olds

You will have excellent spoken English and be a good communicator.

Comfortable using own initiative, prioritising tasks and managing time effectively.

Competent with email, ordering online and entering register data onto excel spreadsheets.

Knowledge of Nursery Rhymes preferred but not essential. Otherwise, we need someone who is willing to quickly learn a stock set of songs suitable for this age group and who will keep working on expanding their repertoire.

Knowledge of Montessori preferred but not essential.

We are committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children. **The successful candidate will be required to have a clear DBS check.**

External candidates will need to provide two references from previous employers.
